

云南大学 2022 年进化生物学专业博士研究生项目 国际学生招生简章（英文授课）

一、招生类别、期限及授课语言

1. 招生类别：进化生物学专业博士研究生。
2. 学习期限：博士研究生 4 学年。
3. 授课语言：英语。

二、申请条件

1. 申请人须为持外国护照的非中国籍公民。对于移民国外的申请者，必须持有有效的外国护照或国籍证明文件 4 年（含）以上，且最近 4 年之内（截至 2022 年 4 月 30 日前）有在国外实际居住 2 年以上的记录（一年中实际在国外居住满 9 个月可按一年计算，以入境和出境签章为准）。

2. 遵守中国的法律法规及学校规章制度，尊重中国人民的风俗习惯，品德良好，学业优异。

3. 申请人身体健康状况应符合国家教育部颁布的“外国来华留学生健康检查标准”。

4. 学历和年龄要求：来华攻读博士学位者，须获得硕士学位，年龄不超过 45 岁。

5. 语言要求：英文水平需要满足以下中一条

①来自以英语为工作语言的国家。

②参加雅思（学术类）或托福水平考试，成绩达到雅思 6.5 分或托福 90 分。

③曾在官方认可的出国英语水平测试中获得合格证书。

三、申请流程

1. 本年度实行线上申请，符合申请条件的申请人须在云南大学国际学生服务平台（<https://ynu.at0086.cn/StuApplication/Login.aspx>）注册账号，按要求提交申请信息并上传申请材料。

2. 申请人须于 2022 年 4 月 8 日前完成线上申请，逾期不予受理。

3. 云南大学进化生物学专业的博士生导师信息详见云南大学生命科学学院官方网站（<http://www.ynusky.ynu.edu.cn/index.htm>）。

四、申请材料

注：以下所有材料都须上传至云南大学国际学生服务平台

（<https://ynu.at0086.cn/StuApplication/Login.aspx>）。所有上传的文件必须清晰、真实且有效。建议申请人使用专业设备扫描相关文件。申请人应当承担因上传材料不明确或无法识别而造成的后果。申请材料如非中、英文文本，需提供公证过的中文或英文翻译件。

1. 《国际学生入学申请表》，请在云南大学国际学生服务平台下载填写。

2. 《外国人体格检查表》，此表格由中国卫生检疫部门统一印制，仅限来华学习的时间超过 6 个月者，须用英文填写。申请人应严格按照《外国人体格检查记录》中要求的项目进行检查。缺项、未贴有本人照片或照片上未盖骑缝章，无医师和医院签字盖章的《外国人体格检查记录》无效。

3. 护照照片页扫描件。

4. 本人证件照，以护照号码命名（照片格式：彩色 2 寸免冠证件照，白色背景无边框，头部占照片尺寸的 2/3，照片尺寸不低于 320*240 像素，高宽比为 4: 3，大小为 100-500KB，JPG 格式）。

5. 经过公证的学历证，如申请人为应届毕业生，可提交本人就读学校出具的预毕业证明，在入学报到时出示原件并补交扫描件。

6. 经过公证的学位证，如申请人为应届毕业生，可提交本人就读学校出具的预毕业证明，在入学报到时出示原件并补交扫描件。

7. 学业成绩单。

8. 学习研究计划，用中文或英文书写，不少于 1000 字。内容应重点包含对申请专

业的认识及申请人的研究方向及目标。

9. 推荐信，用中文或英文书写。提交两名教授或副教授的推荐信，内容应重点包含对申请人来华学习目标要求，中方院校或者中方导师与国外导师的合作情况或者校际交流情况，以及对申请人综合能力，未来发展的评价。

10. 中文语言证书，如已获得 HSK 成绩报告，请附在申请材料中。

11. 英语语言证书，雅思、托福、或其他官方认可的出国英语水平测试证书。

12. 无犯罪记录证明。

13. 经济保证证明。

五、录取及通知

1. 云南大学将组织专家对申请人的申请材料进行评审，视情况组织笔试、面试或其它形式的考核遴选出拟录取人选，对符合条件者，择优录取。

2. 云南大学将在 7 月向已录取学生发送录取材料。

3. 已录取学生入学后原则上不得变更学习专业及学习期限。

六、入学报到

1. 入学报到时间及要求以录取通知书为准。新生报到时应出具上述所有申请材料原件，不能提供真实原件者将被取消录取资格。

2. 如有特殊原因不能按时报到者，须以书面形式提前向我校申请，获批后可延期报到；未经批准不按时报到者，取消入学资格。

I. Admission Category, Duration, and Language of Instruction

1. Admission Category: Evolutionary Biologic Doctoral Degree Program
2. Duration: 4 academic years for doctoral degree students
3. Instruction language: English

II. Application Requirements

1. Applicants must be Non-Chinese citizens. Applicant who immigrated to a foreign country must have held a valid foreign passport or proof of nationality document for at least 4 years and have a record of actual residence abroad for at least 2 years within the last 4 years (until April 30, 2022) (actual residence abroad for 9 months in a year can be counted as one year, based on entry and exit stamps).

2. Applicants should obey the Chinese laws, comply with Yunnan University's regulations, and respect Chinese customs and public ethical norms.

3. Applicants' health condition should conform with the "Health Examination Standards for Foreign Students" issued by the Ministry of Education of China.

4. Applicants must be a master's degree holder under the age of 45.

5. The English level needs to meet one of the following terms:

a) from a country where English is the official language;

b) have taken the IELTS (Academic) or TOEFL level test with an IELTS score of no less than 6.5 or a TOEFL score of no less than 90;

c) have obtained a certificate in officially recognized English Level Test.

III. Application Procedure

1. Online Application

Applicants who meet the requirements can apply on Yunnan University International Student Service System (<https://ynu.at0086.cn/StuApplication/Login.aspx>), and submit all the application document as required.

2. Applicants should complete online application by 8th April, 2022 Beijing Standard Time. Overdue completion and/or incomplete information may result in failure in application.

3. Applicants may check the website of the School of Life Sciences for information of PhD. tutors in Evolutionary Biology Program of Yunnan University at <http://www.ynusky.ynu.edu.cn/index.htm>.

IV. Application Documents

Reminder: All the following documents should be upload on Yunnan University International Student Service System (<https://ynu.at0086.cn/StuApplication/Login.aspx>). All uploaded documents must be clear, authentic and valid. Applicants are recommended to use professional device to scan the relevant documents. Applicants shall bear the consequences caused by unclear or unidentifiable uploaded materials. Notarized translation must be provided if any of the documents listed is not in Chinese or in English.

(1) *Application Form for International Students*. Please download and fill out the form on Yunnan University International Student Service System.

(2) *Foreigner Physical Examination Form*. Applicants planning to stay in China for more than 6 months must submit a photocopy of the Foreigner Physical Examination Form completed in English (the original copy should be kept by the applicant.) The form is designed by the Chinese quarantine authority and can be obtained from the dispatching authority. The physical examinations must cover all the items listed in the Foreigner Physical Examination Form. Incomplete records or those without the signature of the attending physician, the official stamp of the hospital or a sealed photograph of the applicants are invalid. Please select the appropriate time to take physical examination as the result is valid for only 6 months.

(3) Passport photo page.

(4) Personal ID photo, named after passport number (Photo reference format: 2 inch color crown-free ID photo. The white background has no borders, the head accounts for 2/3 of the photo size, the photo size is not less than 320 * 240 pixels, the aspect ratio is 4: 3, the size between 100 KB and 500KB, JPG format.)

(5) Notarized highest degree certificate: Prospective degree winners must submit official proof of student status by their current school. Admitted students need to provide the original degree certificate and submit the scanned copy upon registration.

(6) Notarized highest diploma: Prospective diploma winners must submit official proof of student status by their current university. Admitted students need to provide the original diploma and submit the scanned copy upon registration.

(7) Academic transcripts.

(8) A Study Plan or Research Proposal in Chinese or English. (A minimum of 1000 words.) The study plan must demonstrate an overall understanding of the program to which you are applying and your

research goals and objectives.

(9) Recommendation Letter in Chinese or English. Two letters of recommendation (written only in Chinese or English) from professors or associate professors shall be submitted. These letters shall describe the applicant's objectives of learning in China, comprehensive abilities, and evaluation of future growth, as well as the cooperation between the supervisors or the exchange between universities both in China and abroad.

(10) Chinese Language Certificate. Applicants with valid HSK Certificate should enclose it in the application documents.

(11) English language qualification certificate. e.g. IELTS or TOFEL report.

(12) Non-criminal record report.

(13) Proof of financial guarantee.

V. Admission and Notification

1. After assessment through interviews or other forms of examination conducted by experts from YNU, applicants who meet the requirements will be admitted on a merit basis.

2. YNU will send the admission documents to admitted students in July.

3. Admitted students shall not change their field of study, or duration of study.

VI. Registration

1. Admitted students can refer to "Admission Notice" for the registration time and requirements. Admitted students need to provide all the original application documents upon registration. Failure to provide authentic originals may result in disqualification of admission.

2. Admitted students who are not able to complete registration on time due to any reason need to ask for permission in written form. If admitted students do not register for over two weeks without permission, the admission qualification will be withdrawn.
