Golden milestone

Swimmer Zhu Qianwei made history by claiming China's 1,000th Asian Games gold medal — a feat no other nation has achieved.

The landmark was reached when she won the women's 200m freestyle, 36 years after China first competed in an Asiad at Teheran in 1974.

The team has progressively become more dominant over the years, culminating in winning 165 golds at the last Games in Doha four years ago.
